- Volunteer Management / Sandbag Disposal
 - Salt Lake County has coordinated with municipalities to establish specific locations and dates where you can drop off your sandbags for free. Find specific locations, maps, and dates at Sico.to/dropoff. Drop-off dates are based on when we expect runoff levels to have subsided sufficiently for each area. Used or old sandbags can be disposed of at these dedicated locations or taken to the landfill (subject to fees). Clean sandbags could also be stored or reused following the guidance in this flyer.

- Spring Runoff Funding Tara Behunin
 - The Utah Division of Emergency Management outlined funding opportunities for the 2023 Spring runoff (attached). You will notice an NOI (Notice of Interest) survey is linked to state funding (local disaster fund and H.B. 1001). This survey is the responsibility of all local governments to complete respective to their jurisdiction. There is currently no deadline for submitting the NOI survey should that change, we will let you know. Please look at the attached document to guide you in submitting projects within response and recovery efforts. Remember that the SB 0003 funding was the 1st tranche of money that was awarded back in April/May based on what had been submitted to SLCo EM.
 - Attached here is the matrix containing information on the different funding sources available to DEM as part of Senate Bill 00003, the State Disaster Declaration, and House Bill 1001. The attached matrix identifies the funding source, amount currently or potentially available, eligible applicants, eligible costs, the application process, time frame, and currently determined matching requirements.
